Current Capacity Summary and Enrollment Projections

The chart below shows current capacity use and available classrooms for Elementary schools in the Redmond Learning Community. Voters passed a bond in April 2016 which will allow the district to build two new elementary schools to open in Fall 2018. The new elementary schools will add 1,380 student enrollment capacity or 60 classrooms.

Projected enrollment is determined by taking current students from the elementary schools, moving them ahead a grade in future years, analyzing birth rates and adding in students from known future developments and expected growth.


