MISSING WORK DETAIL PAGE

When [Show All](#) is clicked on the Missing Assignments title, Skyward presents a pop-up window listing all missing assignment with additional details. A common confusion comes from the Absent column. That column indicates if the student was absent when the assignment was due and if the absence was excused. It does not mean the assignment is excused. **Any assignment listed on the report is expected to be turned in.**

This means your student's absence was excused, not the work. If work appears missing in this view, it is expected to be made up.

MISSING WORK DAILY EMAIL

Skyward offers a daily email reporting missing work. To enable this feature, login to Skyward and click on [My Profile](#) in the upper left corner. On the profile page, click the "Receive Grading Emails for my students."

With this feature enabled, Skyward sends a daily email listing missing assignments until the student resolves the missing work with their teacher.

MISSING FLAGS, ZEROS, AND ASTERISKS

Missing assignments receive a score of zero and are marked as missing. The missing flag indicates the student needs to get the work turned in. The student may or may not receive credit for the late work based on teacher policy and the reason for the missing work.

If an assignment receives a zero and the missing flag is not set, that means the student scored a zero for the assignment. If an assignment has an asterisk as a grade, that means the teacher is in the process of grading and there is no action needed from the student. Asterisk scores do not affect the student's current grade.
